Assessment & Grading

Graded and non-graded assessments will be used in the course for formative and summative assessment.

Graded Assessment: Total 100 marks (25 Marks for one credit) 08 Quizzes with 5 items and five marks each (8*5=40) 4 Assignments with 5 marks each (4*5=20). Course end exam with 40 objective types questions one mark for each question (40*1=40)

Non-graded assessment: Discussion forums, Case studies, Group work, practice activities, etc.
